

Parkland Library Card Registration and Renewal

Thank you for your interest in the City of Parkland Library. As a cardholder, you will be able to borrow a variety of materials including books, DVDs, magazines, eBooks, audiobooks and streaming services and also to register for library programs. Please read the following information to understand how to get a library card.

Age Eligibility for Library Cards	Juveniles 5 to 17 with parental signature and identification; adults with proper identification
Parkland Residents FREE OF CHARGE	One photo ID: Driver's license or learner's permit*, school or other photo identification. One proof of address: Driver's license or learner's permit*, utility bill, passport or voter's registration card, all with Parkland address.
Non-Residents \$100 ANNUAL FEE PER CARD	Effective October 1, 2018. Non-residents, 5 years or older, may register for a non-resident card. Non-residents must present one photo ID and one proof of address. Documents accepted for non-residents are the same as listed above for Parkland residents. The cost of the non-resident card is \$100 per card. The card expires one year from the date of issue.
Parkland Teachers (Defined at Right) FREE OF CHARGE	Teachers who teach at one of the five public Broward County schools in Parkland or at Mary Help of Christians K-5 are eligible to receive one card in their name at no charge. The card expires on August 15 of each year. One photo ID and one proof of address (see accepted documents listed above) and one photo proof of school identification is also required.
Parkland Business Owners (Defined at Right) FREE OF CHARGE	One photo ID and one proof of address (see accepted documents listed above) and one proof of Parkland business ownership for the applicant is also required. Only the business owner may apply for a free card.

*A driver's license and learner's permit each may count as proof of address and photo ID. The library reserves the right to request additional proof of identity on any and all applications.

General Policies

- 1) For Parkland residents, library cards expire and must be renewed every two years from date of issue.
- 2) For non-residents, library cards expire and must be renewed one year from date of issue. Also, non-residents must pay \$100 in order to renew the library card for another year.
- 3) All children's programs and some programs for adults require a library card in order to register for the program. Program registration requirements are posted for each program on the library's website.
- 4) Lost cards can be replaced for \$3.00 regardless of the type of card.
- 5) Anyone who uses the library must abide by the behavior policy posted on the library's premises and which is also stated below:

The Parkland Library is a safe place for our community to participate in educational, cultural and personal development. Guidelines encourage positive use of a shared public facility. Engaging in behavior that compromises the comfort and use of the facility, including the library collections, may result in the forfeit of privileges.
