



City of Parkland Community Advisory Board Scholarship Application – 2023

An annual scholarship for post-secondary City of Parkland students made possible through the City of Parkland and the Parkland Community Advisory Board

Dear Applicant:

Congratulations on your choice to continue your education beyond high school. We applaud your decision. The City of Parkland and the Parkland Community Advisory Board believe it is important for all students and citizens to be active in their community. Therefore, we have established a scholarship in recognition of outstanding community or civic service to be used for post-secondary school related expenses. To be eligible for the scholarship opportunity provided by the City of Parkland/Parkland Community Advisory Board, a completed application and all supporting materials must be received by 4:00 PM on Friday, January 27, 2023. Three CAB scholarships will be awarded annually - \$2,000; \$1,200; and \$800.

To apply, you must be a **Parkland resident** eligible for high school graduation in the current year with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. This scholarship seeks to recognize students with outstanding community or civic service above the minimum requirement of 40 service hours. After the initial application is reviewed, an interview will be requested for all finalists.

To be considered for the scholarship, you must provide the following documentation:

- Completed and signed scholarship application
- High school transcript (in sealed envelope from the school)
- Two (2) letters of recommendation -
 - a. One from your guidance counselor or a teacher
 - b. One from an individual who has worked with you on a community project
- **ESSAY OF 250 WORDS OR LESS** – Please attach a brief description of your community involvement with details of your community service project(s). Include a description of the impact your service has had on you.

All of the above items must be submitted by Friday, January 27, 2023, 4:00 PM to:
