However, the company has its own foundation, the Allstate Foundation, which focuses on helping the company be a good corporate citizen. The Allstate Foundation seeks to do this by empowering youth, ending domestic violence, transforming communities, and developing non-profit leaders. In recognition and remembrance of the tragedy at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School ("MSD"), the Allstate Foundation is pleased to announce funding for post-secondary scholarships. The scholarships seek to provide financial assistance for students who share the interests and passions of the students whose lives were tragically ended. These interests include the fine arts, including music, dance, and all forms of the arts, sports, and JROTC.

Two \$500 scholarship will be awarded annually. These scholarships will be awarded to a graduating student at MSD who shares the interests and passions of those whose lives were cut short on February 14th. To apply, you must be graduating from MSD in the current school year with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and submit an essay explaining how this shared interest has influenced your life, past, present and future. The completed application form, high school transcript, and essay must be submitted no later than 4:00 PM on Friday, January 27, 2023. As the City of Parkland will be administering this program on behalf of the Allstate Foundation, scholarship recipients will be determined by the City's Community Advisory Board.

To be considered for these scholarships, you must submit the following documentation:

- Signed, completed application
- High school transcript (in sealed envelope from the school)
- Essay explaining how your shared interest has influenced your life past, present, and future.
